

## ***Diploma Requirements:***

Successful completion of the PASS program will lead to a high school diploma from Wareham Public Schools.

The requirements needed for graduation, 100 credits along with the core academics:

- 4 English courses
- 4 Mathematics courses
- 3 Science courses
- 3 Social Science courses
- 1 Wellness course

Additionally, all students must have passing ELA, Mathematics, and Science/Technology MCAS scores.

**All seniors are required to pay a \$50 graduation fee.**

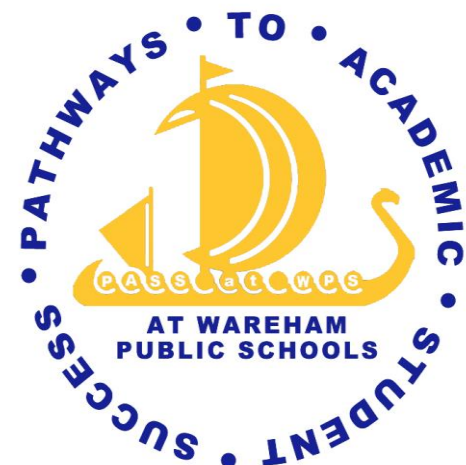

## ***Program Description and Expectations:***

Pathways to Academic Student Success is a night school program of studies for students who wish to complete their high school education and receive a high school diploma from the Wareham Public Schools.

Students who choose to enroll in the PASS Program do so because they are committed to their education. Consistency is the key to commitment. The PASS Program is a work and competency-based program that operates with the same high academic expectations as Wareham High School.

Students should understand that the PASS Program is a voluntary option for students for whom regular WPS daytime classes or classes at another school have not worked. The PASS Program is a second chance to complete coursework towards graduation.

Each student will be expected to review and sign a student and family contract that outlines specific program regulations in addition to the policies outlined in the WPS Student Handbook.
