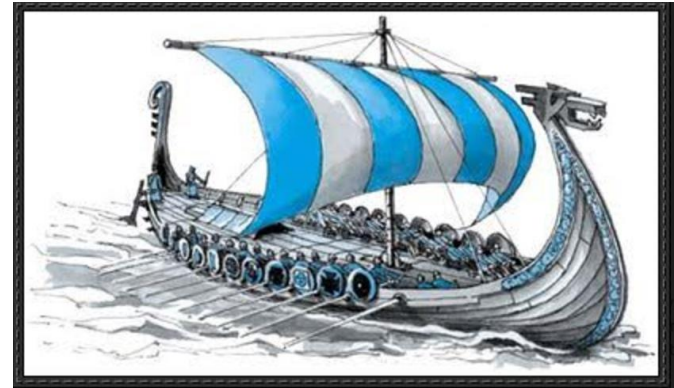

The rating is done by faculty members in the areas of service, leadership, character and citizenship. Students are rated on their performance and behavior during the school day and at school functions. Students also submit an application including an essay to the faculty council. Students will be evaluated and rated after each term. Some students may be dropped and some added through this process. This process encourages students to continue doing an outstanding job in all areas or work harder to become a member.
