

# Summer Food Program

*Breakfasts and lunches for kids and teens*

**Wareham Public Schools will be running its USDA Summer Food Service Program Tuesday June 22 through Friday August 13.**

- Bagged grab-and-go breakfasts and lunches are distributed by Wareham Public Schools Monday through Friday, 10:30 AM to 12:00 PM.
- Meals are for all children 18 years old and younger. No student ID required.
- Children do not have to be present for parents to pick up their meals.
- On Fridays, three bagged breakfasts and three bagged lunches are provided so children have them available on Saturday and Sunday.
- All sites will be closed in observance of Independence Day on Monday July 5.  
On Friday, July 2, four bagged breakfasts and four bagged lunches will be provided.
